



A Message from Pastor Mathew

Last month in worship, we heard these words from **Ephesians 1...**

"In him we have obtained an inheritance, having been predestined according to the purpose of him who works all things according to the counsel of his will, so that we who were the first to hope in Christ might be to the praise of his glory. In him you also, when you heard the word of truth, the gospel of your salvation, and believed in him, were sealed with the promised Holy Spirit, who is the guarantee of our inheritance until we acquire possession of it, to the praise of his glory." - Ephesians 1:11-14

Last August at the NALC Convocation in Pittsburgh, those gathered were introduced to four words that should encompass everything that our congregation embodies. Those four words are: **invite, retain, disciple, and send**. These words fit well into Paul's words to the Ephesians, to the passing on of the faith and value of the inheritance we receive in Jesus. This is something we want to share.

Everything we do in Zion's ministry, what we're currently doing, or what we sense God is leading us in, should fit into one of these four categories. And if something doesn't, then we must seriously consider why we're doing it and whether we should adjust. Last December, our ministries began to discern how these four words were present within their ministry. They also brainstormed ways to ensure that all we do contains a little of all four, even if it means making changes to the way we carry out what we do. But, this doesn't have to just be a big picture brainstorming session. This can take place on an individual level as we ask ourselves how our lives embody these four things. Ponder this with me as it relates to your life as a follower of Jesus.

INVITE: How do you create a welcoming environment where people feel at home, making Zion, your home, or even your workspace a place where faith conversations can come easily?

RETAIN: How do you provide ways for people to connect with you on a faith level, how do you help meet peoples' needs, and make their relationship with you a safe space?

RETAIN: How do you provide ways for people to connect with you on a faith level, how do you help meet peoples' needs, and make their relationship with you a safe space?

DISCIPLE: How do you educate people in their faith and develop their ability to share that faith with others?

SEND: How do you bring people out into the world with you to serve in your community and invite others into the greater mission of God to redeem and restore all people?

I invite you to sit down and discern a bit on how these four words fit into your daily life. Name the places you find yourself throughout the week and consider how these words might become part of your time in those places. And then, ask yourself, how does my daily discipleship live itself to the praise of His glory?

In other words, how does our discipleship show our excitement for and the importance of this salvation we have received in Jesus?
